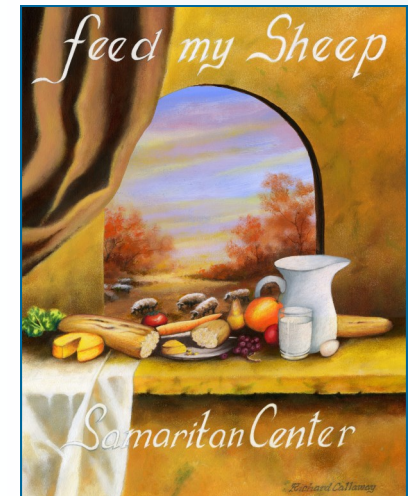

In 2016, your donations helped The Samaritan Center serve 2,699 local families, comprising 3,606 children, 4,052 adults, and 368 seniors.

These families received:

- 2,203 grocery carts filled with food (valued at \$286,390)
- 1,411 personal hygiene care packages (valued at \$16,932)
- \$3,453 in clothing and household items from Gran's Attic

Your donations also enabled us to assist with:

- \$25,852 in utility bills
- \$85,221 in rent and house notes
- \$513 in medical expenses
- \$1,828 in homeless expenses
